# Save our Celery Fields!

A proposed industrial rezoning at the edge of the Celery Fields will permit construction of a 60,000-square-foot wholesale restaurant supply store – dozens of commercial trucks will be coming and going seven days a week. The negative impact on the delicate balance of nature is immeasurable.

On Saturday, Sarasota taxpayers, Neighborhood Association members, bird watchers, and outdoor enthusiasts will be protesting the Sarasota County Commissioners' reckless deal with developers to rezone and sell off county-owned lands that surround the Celery Fields.
